During March 2005, students in grades 7 and 8 in Mankato area public and private schools participated in the Prejudice Reduction Workshops pilot program. Prejudice Reduction Workshops are an initiative of the GMDC and the curriculum teaches respect as its core value. The lessons are age-appropriate, research-driven, and continually evaluated and revised. With the success of the pilot program, the workshops will be expanded to all grades, K-12..
